Treasurer's Report - Richard Fieg

- Receipts for payments made for Nosferatu Event
- Balance with Richard was \$4213.46
- We discussed that a payout was required from GiveButter in order to deposit to our bank. Jennifer was able to do this tonight so an additional \$2255 will be deposited shortly
- Jennifer was able to confirm that she will be closing the Prop L account and will deposit the money back into the Friends account at MRV.
- After the sponsor checks for the Nosferatu Event, our CFO account now holds \$4812.

Library Director's Report-Shawn Long

- Limited Use Agreement - looking to set something up by 1/1/2026, working with the Y on how they will use the space. The Y even suggested making the far entrance the "library entrance" and will be working on increasing the lighting in the hallway.
- Went to ABOS - incorporated a few ideas, "once upon a box" offering them to
- Little Free Library Network throughout the county, still working with the Women's Club
- We are one of the county's that are now asking to be able to get sales tax moving forward. Any changes must be approved through ballot measure.
- Decided to not rehire for Misty's position
- Shawn will be starting the Pages of Generosity that will allow us to show donations to the library and to the Friends. This will be located in the hallway with new lighting. Shawn will be getting a quote on the upper signage and then the donors will be highlighted on book spines that he and Becky will create with the Glowforge.

Old Business

- Nosferatu Review
 - Great event, no critical notes from the public
 - Easiest to split lines for folks that want to purchase at the door
 - Suggest more notice to local advertising, will offer a free ticket to the Herald to assist with coverage.
 - We discussed looking at possibly other movies in the late spring
- Free Art Supply Library
 - New business issue with Becky, waiting to purchase until we hear about that
 - Art Guild has a ton of art for kids in their area - open limited hours
 - Sticker to drive people down to the art guild
 - Jenn will purchase the cabinet and have it delivered to the library.
- Free Christmas Movies
 - Double Feature Christmas movies, reaching out to Aptitude to see about sponsoring
 - Jenn will be setting up the first posts on Facebook
 - Shawn will work on getting the ad in the Herald for the Free Movies
 - Shawn brought up the ornaments, we talked about options for sale - Jenn motioned to approve 100 ornaments, Christine seconded, none opposed
 - Becky mentioned a sing along - let the record show that Becky will lead it or find someone to lead it
 - Jenn will research how to do the cotton candy
 - Decided that we will need to meet again before the event. Meeting planned for 11/20 at 5 pm. Jenn will communicate.

New Business

- **Food Pantry**
 - Becky mentioned having food or meals available for patrons. We discussed all the other organizations collecting and donating food and wondered if it would be good to just donate to them.
 - We will hold off on purchasing a cabinet.
 - Possibly looking at just a collection, get a free book and then we can donate to SVDP or other organization
- **Rock & Roll Bingo - Pretzels from Pretzel place in Festus**

 - We could resell pretzels in bags of sticks or with twists.
